FINAL JUDGMENT

Came on to be heard Defendant National Cutting Horse Association's ("NCHA") Motion for Entry of Judgment (the "Motion"). The sole remaining issue in this case is the amount of attorneys' fees to be awarded to the NCHA. All other issues have been previously disposed of by way of Plaintiffs' non-suit of their claims. The NCHA is the prevailing party on all of Plaintiffs' claims. The parties have agreed and stipulated that all evidence concerning the amount of attorneys' fees to be awarded to the NCHA would be submitted to the Court by affidavit. The Court finds that all such affidavits have been submitted, are made in proper form and timely filed, and the affidavits are properly before the Court.

The Court considered, examined and reviewed the pleadings on file, the affidavit evidence and the Motion. The Court is of the opinion that the NCHA is entitled to entry of a final judgment as requested in the Motion. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the NCHA is granted final judgment against Plaintiffs in this case for recovery of its reasonable and necessary

attorneys' fees in the amount of \$67,728.50 up to the date of this judgment; it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that if this matter is appealed to the Court of Appeals by Plaintiffs and is affirmed, the NCHA recover additional attorneys' fees in the amount of \$20,000.00; if Plaintiffs file a writ of error to the Supreme Court the NCHA recover additional attorneys' fees in the amount of \$15,000.00; and if a writ of error is granted and the judgment is affirmed, the NCHA be awarded additional attorneys' fees in the amount of \$25,000.00; it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all taxable court costs incurred herein be and are hereby taxed against Plaintiffs; it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the judgment granted herein disposes of all claims between the parties and is final.
